

FAMILY CAMP

Guest Guidelines

GENERAL

- No swimming or canoeing after dusk. Never swim or boat alone.
- Children under 11 must be supervised by a parent or older, responsible sibling.
- Parents should escort children 8 and under through the food line.
- No playing or hanging out on the Worship Center stage.
- No children in the barn alone. Parents please supervise younger children when handling barn animals.
- Life jackets are required for all ages while using any boats.
- No running down the camp hill.
- Washers and dryers are for emergencies only.

ATTIRE

We desire to provide an atmosphere of modesty as Scripture demonstrates (Gen. 3:21, 1 Cor. 12:23, 1 Tim. 2:9). While we have freedom in Christ in how we apply the principles of modesty, out of love for others we ask that discretion and deference guide your clothing choices for camp.

This is camp. :) Please bring casual, comfortable clothes that enable you to easily move around and enjoy the various activities we have. We want you to have fun without worrying about constantly adjusting or ruining your clothing.

A few guidelines to note as you pack:

- Footwear is required at all times except while swimming or in your room.
- Clothing should NOT include **references** that are vulgar, obscene, degrade others, or promote drugs, alcohol, or violence.
- **Undergarments** should NOT be visible at any time.
- **Shirts** must cover the top of shorts even when moving (if arm motion shows midriff or stomach, it's too short). No crop tops or low cut necklines. Tank straps must be at least 1 inch wide.
- Shorts must have at least a 4 inch inseam and no holes. No biker shorts.
- Acceptable **swimsuits** include swim trunks, a modest-neckline one-piece, or tankini that comes down to the bottoms. A dark colored t-shirt and possibly shorts may be worn over swimsuits that don't fit these guidelines. A t-shirt and shorts are required whenever not at the pond.
